Juror's Statement

Jurying online is both wonderful and complex. Like any work that can be done online, it is convenient. All content is provided quickly, choices can be made and reassessed and changed, all from the distant comfort of my home laptop or office PC. However, I am a curator, which means that I prefer to work directly with objects. I love to see the size an artist has chosen for a print, its full tonal range, even its frame. These are all important aspects that add to the understanding and interpretation of an image.

While I favor seeing prints in person, time and geographical limitations make online work necessary and useful. It pushes me to move past the artist's technique of choice (I do not have a preference for any particular photographic technique, I only look for one that lends itself to the subject matter at hand) to the image's subject and composition. Judging from a distance also allows me to get a sense for work being made outside of my own city, my own boundaries. I treat all the works submitted as a set. They are compared to one another rather than photographs outside of the set, and are chosen for their ability to stand on their own as well as their potential for creating conversations with the other selected works.

As with many shows in the beautiful Northwest region, many landscapes were submitted. Street scenes, portraits, still lifes, and conceptual photographs demonstrated the many approaches and voices of the twenty-first century artist/ photographer. I hope that the selections work well together, and that unexpected and exciting conversations between the works take place within the gallery.
